Parking

It is your responsibility to park your vehicle in a position where it can be easily driven away. You must leave your vehicle on a gravel or tarmac road, without blocking the way for other campers. The use of car radios, fridges, compressors and other appliances will quickly flatten a car battery. Should you require a 'jump start', tow out or winching service, there will be a charge of £5 per vehicle.

Electric vehicles may only be charged through a designated car charging socket which are available at the main car park, as charging through your pitch or accommodation can present a serious fire hazard.

Health & Safety

Emergency Phone

If you require the emergency services please dial 999 then contact the Duty Warden (please check the notice on the reception door to locate them when reception is closed).

A **defibrillator** is available by the wooden building adjacent to reception. Call 999 for the code or ask a member of staff.



Safety and prevention of carbon monoxide poisoning

Never take a stove, BBQ or lit charcoal into an enclosed space like a tent, caravan, awning or glamping accommodation.

Dogs

Well behaved dogs are welcome on the park but **must be kept on leads at all times**. There is a designated dog walking area indicated on the park map. Dogs must not foul the park. A public footpath leads

from the play area to the hill above the site, Moor How, which gives spectacular views of the surrounding fells and lake. Moor How is privately owned, please keep to the marked footpaths.
